Volunteer Positions to Support Chapter VPs!

Last month we talked about the elections for volunteer positions and the importance of having them filled so that the Chapter remains healthy and providing benefit to members. Some of the positions advertised were board roles. All of them, except the President, were VP positions.

For some of you, the advertised elected positions might appear somewhat overwhelming, however with more volunteers supporting our VPs the workload is manageable - and key to Chapter success. Many of the VP positions have support roles which may be of interest to you. Would you be interested in filling one or more of these roles?

Below are the VP support roles we need volunteers for:

VP Technology

IT/Technology (elected or appointed): responsible for all aspects of chapter technology including acquisition, support/maintenance of tech, data analytics, governance and long range & annual planning of technology.

Webmaster (appointed): serves as the primary contact for all aspects of the chapter's website, handling web design and development, routine site and content maintenance.

VP Programs

Certification (elected or appointed): responsible for promoting PMI's project management certifications among chapter members and the project management community the chapter's territory as leading initiatives on organizing and leading chapter certification programs eg study groups.

Education (elected or appointed): responsible for creating and managing professional development and education programs.

Events (elected or appointed): responsible for the overall planning, promotion and logistics of various chapter seminars, roadshows, workshops, conventions, expos, conferences and other possible in-person, virtual or hybrid events that aim to foster chapter membership.

Mentoring (elected or appointed): responsible for leading, planning, conducting and overseeing the chapter's mentoring program.

Professional Development Champion (appointed): serves as the subject matter expert to help chapter members\non members understand PMI product offerings.

Sponsorship (elected or appointed): develops and executes an integrated sponsorship program to support chapter events and outreach activities.

VP Communications

Communications (elected or appointed): responsible for strategic management and communication of communication channels.

Marketing (elected or appointed): responsible for marketing activities that increases awareness of both the chapter PMI brand within the territory.

Social Media (appointed): responsible for strategizing, optimizing, moderating and maintaining social media channels.

Publications (elected or appointed): responsible for chapter publications to deliver news and increase awareness of chapter activities.

VP Outreach

Academic and Rising Leaders (elected or appointed): responsible for academic outreach targeting students 19-35, faculty and the academic project management communities and related areas of study. Forming sustainable partnerships and yielding mutual benefits for tertiary/higher education institutions.

Business/Corporate (elected or appointed): responsible for developing relationships with the local business community promote adoption of project management practices, the profession and the chapter.

Military (appointed): responsible for serving as liaison between the chapter board, members and the local military as well as a resource to military personnel interested in in PMI for certification support, networking, mentorship and career connectivity.

Social Impact (appointed): responsible for creating outreach opportunities for members passionate about serving the community through teaching of project management skills & experiences; finding social impact activities for members to be involved in.
